Golf Membership Types

- Single** ----- Individual Adult
- Family 2** ----- Married Couple, Domestic Partnership or one adult and one **dependent** child
- Family 3** ----- Married Couple, Domestic Partnership, plus one **dependent** child
 * Family 4, 5, 6, etc. is additional \$25.00 for each additional **dependent** child
- Senior Single**----- Individual Adult at least 62 years old in current year/season
- Senior Couple**----- Married Couple or Domestic Partnership with one individual being at least 62 years old in current year/season
- Junior** ----- Individual Twelve (12) years of age or older enrolled as a full-time student up to and including his/her senior year in high school. Weekday play only—Monday-Friday until 3:00 PM. Must pay greens fees for weekend play.
- College** ----- Full time student twenty-two (22) years of age or less

Dependent Child - Individual being twenty-two (22) years of age or less and a full-time student.

Dependents coming off a Family membership: **For the 1st year only, once a dependent no longer qualifies as a “dependent”, they can purchase their own membership for one-half the cost of a Single.

Cash and checks are accepted for payment. **There will be a 3% charge if using a credit card for payment of membership dues.**

Membership Referral Credit: A \$50.00 credit towards your 2020 membership for sponsoring a new member(s).

New Member(s) will receive a 10% discount on their 2019 memberships (does not apply to 35 and under memberships).

GOLF CART RULES & ETIQUETTE

The Cedardell Golf Course Policy Manual states that golf carts will only be rented to individuals 16 year of age or older with a valid driver license. Season golf carts are rented to a family of one or two, for example a married couple is eligible for a season cart pass. Dependents are not authorized privileges on a season cart pass, unless they are passengers with a parent. It is recommended that season cart holders ride together with other season cart holders, in order to reduce the number of carts on the course. Season cart pass holders are highly encouraged to require that anyone who rides on his/her cart either has their own season cart pass or pays a cart rental fee in the clubhouse. No one should ride in a cart if they have not paid for their seat.

Golf cart rules are designed for your safety, and to protect the turf on the fairways and greens.

Cart Safety

Read the warnings posted in many golf carts about keeping safe when you use a cart, such as limiting use to two passengers/bags and keeping arms and legs inside of the cart. Common sense dictates that the driver should wait until the passenger is seated before accelerating. Drive carefully around the clubhouse and at intersections.

Steering Clear

Keep your cart away from tee boxes, and about 30 feet away from the greens. Signs near the green might say, "No carts beyond this point," or chalk lines may indicate where you should not pass. Do not drive close to tee boxes or bunkers.

Take Care of the Turf

Making sharp turns, or speeding along in the cart and coming to a sudden stop, can damage the turf grass. The same goes for driving through wet or muddy areas, or grass with standing water. Keep the cart away from naturalized areas to protect the grasses and wildlife.

Be Aware of Other Players

For your safety and for the safety of your passenger, do not drive the cart in front of other players in your group or another group. As a courtesy, do not drive forward or back up when a player is addressing the ball.

The 90-Degree Rule

Players should stay on the cart path whenever possible to protect the fairway turf. On some days, especially when the course is wet, you may be asked to follow the 90-degree rule. Under this rule, carts are allowed on the fairway, but they must maintain a 90-degree angle from the edge of the fairway. You must take the cart path to a spot that is even with your ball, make a right angle turn and drive straight toward the ball. This rule may be in effect for all or some holes.

Take It Around the Back

As a courtesy to the group behind you, it is customary to drive the golf cart around the back of the green before putting, or at least before entering scores. This speeds play, since the next group will not be forced to wait while you clear the area.

Golf Cart Damage

If a golf cart is damaged by a patron while the golf cart is leased to that patron, the patron is responsible to pay for all repairs to the golf cart per golf cart agreement. The patron will be notified of the repair costs and will be billed for said repairs.
